GRAND CHAMPIONSHIP AND NATIONAL DIRT TRACK SUPPLEMENTAL RULES

- I. Riders who have held an AMA Pro Sport license in 2005, 2006 or 2007 are eligible for the following classes only: Pro Sport class, 40+ Open, 50+ Open and 18+ Singles or Twins at all Amateur Nationals in the different regions.
- II. Expert and GNC license holders may not ride any class in the Dirt Track Grand Championships.
- III. All riders will be eligible to enter a maximum of three classes.
- IV. Riders who win a Premier class at the Nationals will be eligible for travel assistance from one event only.
- V. Premier classes will be: 50cc Senior, 65cc Modified, 85cc 7-11 Modified, 250cc 4-Stroke Modified, 450cc Modified, and 30+ Open Singles.
- VI. National winners of Premier classes will be eligible and are encouraged to display their color coded numbers at the Grand Championships as follows: Region #1(NE) blue with yellow #'s, Region #2(SE) green with white #'s, Region #3(NC) yellow with black #'s, Region #4(SC) orange with black #'s, Region #5(NW) red with white #'s.
- VII. Knobby tires will NOT be permitted.
- VIII. Minimum of five entries to make a class.
- IX. Premier Champions from the National Events will be seeded into the heats before the remainder of the field is set.

All mechanics, family members ages 3+, sponsors, etc., must purchase pit passes at sign-up or at race track each morning. Pit passes are \$10 per person, per day.

Pit passes will not be sold in advance.

Attention parents and guardians; if rider is under the age of 18, a parent or guardian *must* be present at registration with rider to sign all release forms. Anyone purchasing a pit pass must be present to sign release. Pit passes will be sold during registration.
